Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Payment by an Employer when
a Physician's Certification of Illness is Required."


Amend the bill in that part designated "§592." in
the second sentence (page 1, line 32 in L.D.) by
striking out after the underlined words "the cost of"
the underlined word "any" and inserting in its place
the underlined word 'a'

Further amend the bill in that part designated
"§592." in the second sentence (page 1, line 33 of
L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "office"
and before the underlined punctuation", " the follow-
ing underlined words 'to obtain the certificate'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to make it
clear that an employer is only responsible for paying
the cost of the employee's visit to the physician's
office to obtain the required certificate, not for
any other visits the employee may make to the physi-
cian.
