AN ACT to Provide Funds for Alternate
Crop Research.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to provide state
3 funds in response to a strong interest in alterate
4 crop research of broccoli, cabbage, cauliflower, oil
5 crops and small seed. Research is needed to identify
6 variety and cultural practices, handling and storage
7 and practices to maximize profit potential of crops.
8 Research would take place at the Aroostook Experimen-
9 tal Farm in Presque Isle and moneys would go to the
10 Maine Potato Commission Research Committee for dis-
11 persal.

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
