- 2. Committees; corporations; associations. No political committee, other committee, corporation or association shall may make contributions to a candidate, in support of the candidacy of one person, in an aggregate amount greater than \$5,000 in any election or in excess of the provisions of subsection 7.
- 7 Sec. 3. 21 MRSA §1395, sub-§§7 and 8 are enacted 8 to read:

- 7. Contribution limitation per candidate. No candidate may accept any contribution that exceeds the limit established on total contributions to candidates required by this subsection. The total amount of contributions a candidate may accept is as follows.
  - A. Contributions to a candidate in a primary election for the nomination as a candidate for the office of Governor shall not exceed \$1 for every vote cast for Governor in the last general election.
    - B. Contributions to a candidate for election to the office of Governor, not including a primary election, shall not exceed \$3 for every vote cast for Governor in the last general election.
    - C. Contributions to a candidate in a primary election for the nomination as a candidate for the office of United States Senator from Maine shall not exceed \$1 for every vote cast in the candidate's district in the last general election for the office of United States Senator.
- D. Contributions to a candidate for the election to the office of United States Senator from Maine shall not exceed \$3 for every vote cast in the candidate's district in the last general election for this office.
  - E. Contributions to a candidate in a primary election for the nomination to be a candidate for the office of United States Representative from Maine shall not exceed 50¢ for every vote cast in the candidate's district in the last general

- F. Contributions to a candidate for the election to the office of United States Representative from Maine shall not exceed \$1.50 for every vote cast in the candidate's district in the last general election for the office of United States Representative.

- I. Contributions to a candidate in a primary election for nomination as a candidate for the office of Representatives in the Maine House of Representative shall not exceed 20¢ for every vote cast in the candidate's district in the last general election for this office.
- J. Contributions to a candidate for the election to the office of Representative in the Maine House of Representatives shall not exceed 60¢ for every vote cast in the candidate's district in the last general election for this office.
- 31 K. Contributions to a candidate in a primary

  - L. Contributions to a candidate for an elected county office shall not exceed 30¢ for every vote cast for that office in the candidate's county for that specific office.

- M. Contributions to a candidate for an elected municipal office shall not exceed 20¢ for every vote cast in the last general election for that office in the municipality for which the candidate seeks election.
  - N. Contributions to any political committee, political action committee, person or organization that seeks to influence the outcome, in any way, of a vote in an election on a referendum or initiated petition shall not exceed 40¢ for every vote cast on a referendum question that received the greatest number of votes in the last general election.
  - 8. Excess revenues. Any excess revenues derived from contributions to any candidate as defined by subsection 7 shall be returned to the contributor by the candidate no later than 5 business days following receipt of the contribution.

## 19 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill limits total contributions to political candidates as a means of making the election process more equitable. The intent is to reduce the role that wealth plays in the political process.

According to this bill, the following limits are placed on total contributions to a candidate:
