18 Maximum amount of benefits. The maximum 4. 19 amount of benefits which shall be paid to any eligi-20 ble individual with respect to any benefit year, 21 whether for total or partial unemployment, shall not 22 exceed the lesser of 26 times his average weekly ben-23 1/3%, amount or 33 efit rounded to the nearest 24 dollar, of his total wages paid for insured work 25 during his base period, plus the supplemental weekly 26 benefit for dependents payable under subsection 6.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

At present, a claimant's maximum weekly unemploy-28 ment benefit is fixed at 52% of the annual average 29 30 weekly wage paid in the year preceding the period running from June 1st to May 31st in which he 31 filed 32 his claim. If the claimant is still receiving bene-33 fits when the maximum is adjusted the following June 1st, and the maximum is increased because the average 34 35 annual weekly wage has increased, his maximum benefit 36 stays at the old amount while people who file a claim 37 after June 1st receive benefits at the new maximum 38 This bill changes the present law to amount. allow 39 such a claimant to receive the increased maximum ben-40 efit.

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
