17 AN ACT Amending the Motor Vehicle Registra-

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §246, 4th ¶, as amended by PL 1973, c.
23 614, §2, is further amended to read:

24 The term "agricultural commodities" ~~shall include~~
25 includes logs, lumber and pulpwood cut on a farm or
26 farms owned by the registrant and food harvested from
27 clam flats or other foods harvested through
28 aquacultural practices. Farm motor trucks registered
29 under this section may receive a short-term permit in
30 accordance with this section by paying a percentage
31 of the difference between the amount paid for farm
32 motor truck registration and the annual fee for the
33 desired tonnage in accordance with the permit table
34 contained in this section.
