STATEMENT OF FACT

4 Current Maine law requires self-insured employers 5 to file detailed information with the Superintendent 6 so as to allow the superintendent to of Insurance 7 employer's financial ability monitor an to self-insure for workers' compensation purposes. 8 Much 9 of this information is of a confidential nature as 10 between competitors and should not be made available 11 simply upon request. In addition, access to such 12 information in regard to specific pending workers' compensation cases, such as case-by-case reserves, 13 will further burden and delay settlement of workers' 14 15 compensation cases.

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
