17 AN ACT to Clarify the Maine Motor
18 Vehicle Habitual Offender Statute.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §2298, first ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c.
23 541, Pt. B, §34, is further amended to read:

24 It shall be unlawful for any person to operate
25 any motor vehicle on a public way in this State while
26 the revocation prohibiting its operation remains in
27 effect. Any person found to be an habitual offender
28 under this chapter, or former chapter 18, who is
29 thereafter convicted of operating a motor vehicle in
30 this State while the revocation prohibiting operation
31 is in effect shall have committed a Class C crime.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies the motor vehicle habitual offender statute by specifying the area where operation of a motor vehicle is actually prohibited.

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
