10	Amend the Bill after the amending clause by
11	striking out all of paragraph K and inserting in its
12	place the following:
13	K. Providing for the establishment and policing
14	of parking spaces designated for handicapped per-
15 16	sons. A municipality with off-street public
17	parking areas may set aside an adequate number of
18	these spaces for use by handicapped persons. A municipality with on-street public parking spaces
19	may set aside an adequate number of these spaces
20	in appropriate locations for use by handicapped
21	persons. There shall be adjacent to and visible
22	from each handicapped parking space a posted sign
23	consisting of a profile view of a wheelchair with
24	eccupant in white on a blue background and bear-
25	ing the following warning: "Handicapped Parking-
26	Special Plate Required. Unauthorized vehicles
27	are subject to a fine- " The municipality may post
28 29	any of the signs authorized by this paragraph ad-
30	jacent to and visible from each handicapped park- ing space. One sign shall consist of a profile
31	view of a wheelchair with an occupant in white on
32	a blue background with a printed inscription.
33	The inscription shall read: "Handicapped Park-
34	ing: Special Plate Required. Unauthorized vehi-

replaced after the effective date of this para-2 graph shall conform to the signs authorized by this paragraph. Any existing posted signs that do not conform to the provisions of this para-3 4 5 graph and which were erected prior to the effec-6 tive date of this paragraph shall be deemed to be 7 valid for enforcement purposes. Any vehicle 8 parked in a parking space designated by a munici-9 pality as a handicapped parking space that does 10 not bear a special registration plate or placard 11 issued under Title 29, section 252, or a similar plate issued by another state, shall be cited for a penalty not to exceed \$25 unless otherwise 12 13 14 established by local ordinance. Owners of private off-street parking may enter into agreements 15 16 with local or county law enforcement agencies for 17 the policing of stalls and spaces dedicated for handicapped persons' vehicles, under which agree-18 19 ments unauthorized vehicles shall be tagged.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to require any new handicapped parking signs posted by a municipality after the effective date of Title 30, section 2151, subsection 2, paragraph K, to include a profile of a wheelchair with an occupant in white on a blue background. Any signs pertaining to handicapped parking presently posted will be deemed valid for law enforcement purposes.
