17 AN ACT Concerning Loose Wood
18 Measurement.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 10 MRSA §2302, sub-§1, ¶A-2, as amended by PL
23 1981, c. 219, is further amended to read:

24 A-2. Fuel wood, when sold loose and not ranked
25 and well stowed, shall be sold by the cubic foot or
26 loose cord, unless other arrangements are made
27 between the buyer and seller. When sold by the loose
28 cord, the wood in any cord shall average either 12
29 inches, 16 inches or 24 inches in length. When so
30 sold, the volume of the cords shall be: A cord of 12
31 or 16 inches in length shall mean the amount of wood,
32 bark and air contained in a space of ~~180~~ 160 cubic
33 feet; and a cord of wood 24 inches in length shall
34 mean the amount of wood, bark and air contained in a

1 space of ~~195~~ 180 cubic feet.

2 STATEMENT OF FACT

3 The purpose of this bill is to change the re-
4 quired cubic foot measurement for a cord of loose
5 firewood.

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
