14 15 16	IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE
17 18 19	AN ACT to Provide Improved Dental Care by Amending the Denturist Law.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1100-E, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1977, c. 696, §236, is further amended to read:
24 25 26 27 28 29 30	2. <u>License issued</u> . The board shall issue a li- cense for the practice in this State to each person who has passed the examination under section 1100-D or who has met the equivalency and training standards established in section 1100-I. This license shall authorize the licensee to practice as a denturist in the State for the year in which it is issued.
31 32 33	Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1100-F, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 484, §2, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

1 2 3 4 5	A person who is otherwise qualified for licensure under this subchapter shall not be denied a license based on the unauthorized performance of dental tech- nology services by that person prior to issuance of the license.
6	Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §1100-I is enacted to read:
7	§1100-I. Equivalency training and experience stan-
8	dards
9 10 11 12	A person who has satisfied the requirement of this section shall be considered qualified by virtue of equivalency training and experience for issuance of a license to practice denture technology.
13 14	1. Age. Is at least 18 years of age and a resi- dent of this State.
15	2. Training. Has completed:
16	A. Fifty hours of anatomy study;
17	B. Fifty hours of bacteriology study;
18	C. Fifty hours of inter-oral procedures study;
19	D. Fifty hours of inter-oral practice; and
20	E. Fifty hours of oral physiology study.
21	3. Experience. Has:
22 23	A. Participated in all laboratory phases of den- ture technology for 5 years; or
24 25 26 27	B. Completed 2 years of dental laboratory educa- tion in all laboratory phases of denture technol- ogy and 3 years of participation in all phases of laboratory denture technology.
28 29 30 31 32	4. Documentation. An applicant for licensure based on equivalency training and experience shall provide documentation of the equivalency training and experience which he claims to the board. The board shall verify the accuracy of that documentation.

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1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5	This bill establishes equivalency training and experience standards for issuance of a denturist's license and requires the Board of Dental Examiners to issue a license when the standards have been met.
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
