11 12	Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:
13 14 15	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
16 17 18	Whereas, some of the school units which allow for the election of alternates will hold elections in the spring; and
19 20 21	Whereas, the alternates would not be able to vote when the regular member was absent until the fall; and
22 23 24 25 26 27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
28 29	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:
30 31 32	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
