17 AN ACT to give Alternates the right to
18 Vote on a School Board.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 20-A MRSA §1653, sub-§2, ¶C, as enacted by PL
23 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

24 C. If a district school committee member is ab-
25 sent from a meeting, the senior nonvoting member
26 shall be allowed all the rights and privileges of
27 the absent member, with the exception of the
28 right to vote. This paragraph shall apply only
29 to a member who is the sole representative of a
30 municipality on the district school committee.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to allow an alternate
3 the right to vote on a school board.

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
