such a vacancy exists. Within 14 days from the date of the Governor's notification, the county committee shall caucus for the specific purpose of nominating individual to the vacant office. The committee's choice shall be communicated to the Governor within 5 working days. If the county official was not a member of a formal political party, the Governor select and appoint his replacement.

The appointment by the Governor of a replacement for the former county official shall be for the remainder of that official's term of office or until the next general election, whichever occurs first.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

 The purpose of this bill is to insure that when the voters of a county elect Republicans or Democrats as their county officials, the successors to these officials, in cases where the officials do not or cannot complete their term of office, be appointed from the same political party that won the position by vote of the electorate.
