17 AN ACT to Regulate Striped Bass Fishing.  
18

---

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
20 follows:

21 12 MRSA §6555, as amended by PL 1981, c. 231, is  
22 repealed and the following enacted in its place:

23 §6555. Striped bass; method of taking

24 It shall be unlawful to fish for or take striped  
25 bass in the coastal waters, except by hook and line  
26 or, between sunrise and sunset, by use of a spear.

27 It shall be unlawful to take or possess striped  
28 bass which are less than 16 inches fork length.

29 No more than 4 striped bass less than 24 inches  
30 fork length may be taken in any one day.
