lature which shall convene after the adoption of this 1 2 amendment shall cause the multi-member districts of 3 the House of Representatives to be divided into dis-4 tricts for the choice of one Representative for each 5 district, dividing contiguous districts the least 6 number of times necessary to establish as nearly as practicable equally populated districts. The 7 Legis-8 lature which convenes in 1983 and every tenth year thereafter shall cause the State to be divided 9 into 10 districts for the choice of one Representative for The number of Representatives estab-11 each district. 12 lished for the following legislative biennium shall 13 be divided into the number of inhabitants of the 14 State exclusive of foreigners not naturalized accord-15 ing to the latest Federal Decennial Census or a State 16 Census previously ordered by the Legislature to coin-17 cide with the Federal Decennial Census, to determine a median population figure for each Representative 18 19 Each Representative District shall District. be 20 formed of contiguous and compact territory and shall 21 cross political subdivision lines the least number of 22 times necessary to establish as nearly as practicable 23 equally populated districts. Whenever the population 24 of a municipality entitles it to more than one dis-25 all whole districts shall be drawn within trict, municipal boundaries. Any population remainder within 26 the municipality shall be included in a district 27 28 drawn to cross the municipal boundary, provided that 29 such population remainder of the municipality must be 30 contiguous to another municipality or municipalities 31 included in the district.

32 Constitutional referendum procedure; form of 33 question; effective date. Resolved: That the city aldermen, town selectmen and plantation assessors of 34 35 this State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in 36 37 the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide 38 election, at a statewide election, on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November following the 39 40 passage of this resolution, to vote upon the ratification of the amendment proposed in 41 this resolution 42 by voting upon the following question:

43 "Shall the Constitution of Maine be amended as 44 proposed by a resolution of the Legislature to reduce 45 the size of the House of Representatives from 151 to 46 99 members?"

1 The legal voters of each city, town and 2 plantation shall vote by ballot on this question, and 3 shall designate their choice by a cross or check mark 4 placed within the corresponding square below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots shall be received, 5 sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and 6 7 plantation meetings and returns made to the Secretary 8 of State in the same manner as votes for members of 9 the Legislature. The Governor shall review the 10 returns and, if it appears that a majority of the 11 legal votes are in favor of the amendment, the Gover-12 nor shall proclaim that fact without delay and the 13 amendment shall become part of the Constitution on 14 the date of the proclamation.

15 Secretary of State shall prepare ballots.
16 Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall prepare
17 and furnish to each city, town and plantation all
18 ballots, returns and copies of this resolution neces19 sary to carry out the purposes of this referendum.

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

21 The purpose of this resolution is to reduce the 22 size of the House of Representatives from 151 to 99.
