1 shall bear reflector tapes when in use in the nighttime or at other times when motor vehicles are re-2 3 quired to display headlamps by section 1366. Every 4 bicycle, motorized bicycle or tricycle operated on any public way shall be equipped with a reflector arm 5 6 projecting horizontally from the side of the bicycle, motorized bicycle or tricycle toward the traveled 7 8 portion of the public way. Every bicycle, motorized 9 bicycle or tricycle shall be equipped with a brake 10 which shall enable the operator to stop the bicycle, 11 motorized bicycle or tricycle within a reasonable 12 distance.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this bill is to require that bicy-15 cles, motorized bicycles and tricycles be equipped 16 with reflector arms when operated on any public way.
