21 22 23	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
24 25 26 27	Whereas, prompt determination of the cost of the Spruce Budworm Spray Project is necessary in order to establish preproject taxes to be assessed on landowners in the spray program area; and
28 29 30 31 32 33	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3 4 5 6	Spruce budworm spray project cost. In accordance with the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 8426, the Legislature determines the cost of the 1982 Spruce Budworm Spray Project is \$6,230,000.
7 8 9	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
10	STATEMENT OF FACT
11 12 13 14	This bill authorizes the cost of the 1983 Spruce Budworm Spray Project so that funds can be raised through the budworm excise tax to carry out the project.
