18 which an Agency Liquor Store may be Open.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 28 MRSA §154, first ¶, as repealed and replaced
23 by PL 1975, c. 741, §11, is amended to read:

24 State retail liquor stores and state agency
25 stores may be open for the sale and delivery of liq-
26 uor between the hours of 9 6 a.m. and midnight in
27 municipalities and unincorporated places which have
28 voted affirmatively on section 101, subsection 1. The
29 State Liquor Commission shall establish the hours of
30 operation of each state retail liquor store and state
31 agency store.
