17 AN ACT Concerning Property Tax Exemptions
18 for Veterans.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 36 MRSA §653, sub-§2 is enacted to read:

23 2. Other veterans. Veterans paying a property
24 tax, who otherwise qualify for an exemption under
25 subsection 1, shall not be ineligible solely because
26 their obligation to pay taxes arises from a bond for
27 deed.

28 STATEMENT OF FACT

29 This bill permits veterans paying a property tax
30 to claim an exemption if they are purchasing their
31 property under a bond for deed rather than a tradi-
32 tional mortgage.

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
