- 2. Passenger vehicle. Every truck, bus and multi-purpose passenger vehicle manufactured after July 1, 1971, shall be equipped with a lap belt assembly or with a lap or shoulder belt assembly in the driver's seating position.
  - 3. Truck tractors. Every truck tractor manufactured or assembled after January 1, 1965, that is designed to draw a vehicle with a gross weight over 10,000 pounds shall be equipped with a lap belt assembly in the driver's seating position.

- Every driver of a motor vehicle subject to section 1368-A shall wear a properly adjusted and fastened seat belt, except drivers of motor vehicle operators who:
- 18 <u>1. Persons frequently leaving vehi-</u>
  19 cle. Frequently stop and leave the vehicle or deliv20 ering property from the vehicle as long as the speed
  21 of the vehicle between stops does not exceed 15 miles
  22 per hour; or
- 23 2. Physicians statement. Possess written con-24 firmation from a physician that he is unable for med-25 ical or physical reasons to wear a seat belt.
- 26 §1368-D. Passengers to wear seat belts
- Every passenger in a vehicle operated on a highway, other than the driver, shall wear a properly adjusted and fastened seat belt if his seating position is so equipped, unless that use is not possible, safe or reasonable or unless the passenger is medically exempted by possessing written confirmation from a physician.
- 34 §1368-E. Penalties
- Violation of the provisions of this section constitutes a misdemeanor and persons convicted shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$50.
