17 AN ACT to Provide for the Negotiation
18 of Union Security Provisions.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 26 MRSA §964, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

23 2-A. Negotiation of union security. Nothing in
24 this chapter may be interpreted to prohibit the nego-
25 tiation of union security, except in closed shop.

26 STATEMENT OF FACT

27 The purpose of this bill is to permit the nego-
28 tiation of union security provisions into collective
29 bargaining agreements for municipal public employees.
30 It would offer them the same rights as now possessed
31 by employees of the University of Maine, the

1 vocational-technical institutes and the Maine Mari-
2 time Academy. It clarifies the law to clearly indi-
3 cate that union security is a negotiable item in con-
4 tracts with municipal employees.
