17 AN ACT to Deny Certain State Funds to Any
18 Person Who Refuses to Register under the
19 United States Military Selective Services Act.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 1 MRS.A c. 34 is enacted to read:

24 CHAPTER 34

25 PERSONS FAILING TO REGISTER UNDER
26 UNITED STATES MILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICES ACT

27 §3001. Eligibility for state programs

28 Any person who is required under the United
29 States Military Selective Services Act to present
30 himself for and submit to registration and fails to
31 do so, in accordance with any rule issued under that

1 Act, shall be ineligible to participate in any state
2 program. Any such person who applies for participa-
3 tion in any state program included under the provi-
4 sions of this chapter shall provide a copy of the
5 letter of acknowledgement as proof that he has sub-
6 mitted to registration.

7 §3002. Rules

8 The Governor shall determine which state programs
9 are included under the provisions of this chapter and
10 shall promulgate rules, in accordance with the Maine
11 Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375,
12 establishing the procedures which shall be followed
13 in carrying out the provisions of this chapter.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This bill prevents persons who refuse to register
16 under the United States Military Selective Services
17 Act from participating in and receiving economic ben-
18 efits from state programs.
