IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for a Reduced Fee for
Lobster Fishing Licenses for Persons 70 years
of Age and Older.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §6421, sub-§7, as amended by PL 1981, c. 480, §1, is further amended to read:

7. Fee. The fee for the license shall be \$33 for applicants 17 years of age or older and under 70 years of age, and \$13 for those applicants under 17 years of age or 70 years of age or older.

STATEMENT OF FACT

3 This new draft provides commercial lobster and
4 crab licenses to persons 70 years of age or older for
5 \$13, the same as the fee for persons under 17. There
6 are no special restrictions on this license. This
7 new draft will result in a loss of approximately
\$6,000 annually to the General Fund.
