17 AN ACT Relating to the Mandatory
18 Inspection of Motor Vehicles.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §2502, first ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c.
23 607, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in its
24 place:

25 Automobiles registered in Maine which are 5 years
26 old or less are subject to an annual inspection as
27 provided in this chapter. Automobiles registered in
28 Maine which are more than 5 years old are subject to
29 the same inspection standards, but the inspections
30 are required on a semiannual basis. The age of the
31 vehicle is determined by the model year of the auto-
32 mobile. The Chief of the State Police will furnish
33 official inspection stations with stickers of 2 dif-
34 ferent colors to distinguish vehicles 5 years old or
35 less from vehicles more than 5 years of age.
