court at its deseretion discretion. The decision concerning a request for excuse shall be made by the presiding justice or by a clerk of court acting under supervision of the presiding justice. Depending upon the circumstances, except in the case of a prospective juror over 65 years of age, such a juror may excused from jury service finally, be required to serve at a later specific time or be required to period of time less than the usual 15 for a serve court days. The juror qualification form shall give a person over 65 years of age the opportunity to indicate that he seeks an excuse from jury service finally. The clerk shall enter this the determination and the reason therefor in the appropriate record kept for that purpose.

23 24 The purpose of this bill is to make jury service optional for persons over 65 years of age. The bill permits a prospective juror over 65 to seek an excuse from jury service, though those over 65 who wish to serve need not be excused. The bill requires the juror qualification form to give the prospective juror over 65 the option of indicating that he does not want to serve on a jury.
