Second, the term "manufacturer" is defined to address other entities, such as importers, who are responsible on express warranties. |
| 13<br>14<br>15<br>16<br>17 | The amendment also clarifies that the presumption contained in Title 10, section 1163, subsection 3, paragraph B applies equally, whether a vehicle is being repaired for one nonconformity or a series of nonconformities for a total of 30 or more business days.  |
