Amend the amendment in the 13th paragraph after  
the title, in the 4th line from the end (page 3, line  
32 in amendment), by inserting after the underlined  
word "plan" the following: 'or a plan of its own'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the  
end before the emergency clause the following:

'4. Funding. Equal amounts of money shall be  
made available through the commission to the 2 major  
parties represented on the commission for the purpose  
of this apportionment. In addition, sufficient funds  
shall be made available to the chairman of the com-  
mission. The commission shall recommend to the  
Legislature if that body is in session, otherwise to  
the Legislative Council, an appropriation sufficient  
to cover the cost of reapportionment.'
