1	No hospital may be liable for collecting or withdraw-
2	ing blood from a juvenile, at the request of a law
3	enforcement officer, pursuant to this section, for
4	the reason that the hospital did not obtain consent
5	from that juvenile's parent or guardian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this bill is to give hospitals 8 limited immunity for giving blood-alcohol level tests 9 to juveniles suspected of operating a motor vehicle 10 under the influence of alcohol. The immunity given 11 by this bill only extends to giving these tests with-12 out the consent of the juvenile's parent or guardian.
