17 AN ACT to Amend the Fraud Provisions of
18 the Maine State Retirement System
19 Statutes.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 5 MRSA §1004, as amended by PL 1977, c. 696, §37,
24 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

25 §1004. Protection against fraud

26 Whenever the executive director determines that a
27 fraud, attempted fraud or a violation of law in con-
28 nection with funds administered by the retirement
29 system may have occurred, he shall report in writing
30 all information concerning such fraud or violation to
31 the Attorney General or his delegate for such action
32 as he may deem appropriate, including civil action
33 for recovery of funds and criminal prosecution by the

1 Attorney General. The executive director shall, upon
2 request of the Attorney General and in such a manner
3 as he deems appropriate, assist in the recovery of
4 funds.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 At the present time, there is no provision in the
7 Maine State Retirement System statutes relating to
8 fraud. The provision that this bill repeals deals
9 with the correction of errors and is unnecessary, as
10 that subject is dealt with in Title 5, section 1031,
11 subsection 8.
