17 AN ACT to Fund a Marketing Study on the
18 Effects of Lowering Liquor Prices Throughout
19 the State.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec.1. Director of Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages
24 to contract for marketing study. The Director of the
25 Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages is directed to hire
26 necessary consultants to conduct a marketing study on
27 the economic effects of lowering retail liquor prices
28 throughout the State. The director shall report to
29 the Second Regular Session of the 111th Legislature
30 by February 15, 1984, with the conclusions and recom-
31 mendations of the study, including any necessary
32 legislation.

33 Sec.2. Appropriation. The following funds are
34 be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out
35 the purposes of this Act.
