17 AN ACT Relating to the Storage of Malt  
18 Beverages under the Liquor Law.  
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 28 MRSA §751, as amended by PL 1977, c. 292, §4,  
23 is further amended by adding at the end a new para-  
24 graph to read:

25 Wholesalers or their employees delivering malt  
26 liquor or table wine to any retail store licensed  
27 pursuant to this section may, with the permission of  
28 the owner or manager of the retail store, place malt  
29 liquor or table wine in stock, on shelves or on dis-  
30 plays in the retail store and may add to or remove  
31 malt liquor or table wine from that stock from time  
32 to time. The commission may not, by regulation, pro-  
33 hibit those wholesalers from being allowed to handle  
34 that stock of malt liquor or table wine.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to permit wholesalers  
or distributors to place malt liquor and table wine  
in stock of any licensed retail store and to maintain  
the stock.

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
