21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §678, first ¶, as amended by PL
24 1977, c. 674, §5, is further amended to read:

25 An appointing authority may dismiss, suspend or
26 otherwise discipline an employee for cause. This
27 right is subject to the right of appeal and arbitra-
28 tion of grievances set forth in sections 751 to 753,
29 or by personnel rule; and said sections 751 to 753
30 shall apply to any employee who has satisfactorily
31 completed an initial probationary period. ~~This para-~~
32 ~~graph shall not apply to an employee appointed to a~~
33 ~~major policy-influencing position listed in section~~
34 ~~711, subsection 2.~~
