17 AN ACT to Define Cider.
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
20 follows:

21 7 MRSA §543-A is enacted to read:

22 §543-A. Cider

23 No person may sell, advertise, offer or expose
24 for sale any product labeled as "cider" if that
25 product has been cooked. For the purposes of this
26 section, "cooked" means heated to a temperature of
27 180° Fahrenheit or higher.

28 STATEMENT OF FACT

29 The purpose of this bill is to prevent any
30 product being labeled as cider if the product has

1 been heated to a temperature of 180° Fahrenheit or
2 higher.

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
