24 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §9501, sub-§2, as enacted by  
25 PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

27 beauty culture which are subject to approval by the  
28 State Board of Cosmetyology, educational Educational  
29 programs related to the real estate professions which  
30 are subject to approval under Title 32, chapter 59,  
31 educational programs offered by any Maine nonprofit  
32 corporation, any educational programs offered by any  
33 professional or trade association primarily for the  
34 benefit of its own members and any institution
