Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause the follow-
ing: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill in subsection 1 in the 5th
paragraph in that part relating to "Boothbay Region
Waterfowl Sanctuary" in the last line (page 4, line 5
in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word and
punctuation "Bath." the following: 'For provisions
relating specifically to Boothbay Region Waterfowl
Sanctuary, see section 7654, subsection 8, paragraph
A, subparagraph (4) and paragraph C, subparagraph
(2).'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7654, sub-§8, 1A, as enacted
by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

A. Notwithstanding subsections 1 and 2:

(1) Those subsections shall not apply to
crows and skunks on the Willow Water Game
Sanctuary;

(2) A person residing within the limits of
the York Game Sanctuary in the County of
Franklin may kill any wild bird, except
grouse, or any wild animal, except beaver,
when found destroying his property;

2 Elizabeth Sanctuary may kill any wild bird,
3 except ruffed grouse or Hungarian partridge,
4 or any wild animal, when found destroying

6 (4) A person may trap any wild animal
7 except moose, caribou, deer and elk within
8 Boothbay Region Waterfowl Sanctuary,
9 Fairfield Sanctuary, Narragansett Game
10 Sanctuary and Prout's Neck, Richmond's
11 Island and Cape Elizabeth Sanctuary in ac-
12 cordance with the general laws of the State.

13 Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7654, sub-§8, ¶C, as enacted by
14 PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

15 C. Notwithstanding subsections 1 and 3:

16 (1) The Camden Rifle Club may establish and
17 maintain a rifle range for target practice
18 within the limits of Megunticook Lake and
19 Vicinity Sanctuary, this target practice to
20 be held under the regulations of the United
21 States War Department as established by the
22 national board for the promotion of rifle
23 practice in the United States; and

24 (2) The use of firearms on Boothbay Region
25 Waterfowl Sanctuary, Megunticook Lake and
26 Vicinity Sanctuary is prohibited only from
27 the first day of April of each year to the
28 30th day of September following.'
