COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 298,

L.D. 912, Bill, "AN ACT to Improve the Administra-

tion of Agricultural Fairs."

Amend the bill in section 1, paragraph C (page 1,  
11 line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the figure "\$750"  
12 and inserting in its place the underlined figure  
13 '\$1,200'

14

Further amend the bill in section 3 in the 14th  
15 line after the amending clause (page 2, line 23 in  
16 L.D.) by striking out the underlined word and figure  
17 "December 1st" and inserting in their place the  
18 underlined word and figure 'November 15th'

19

Further amend the bill in section 3 in the 16th  
20 line (page 2, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the  
21 4th sentence a new sentence to read:

22

'Assignment of fair dates by the Department of Agri-  
23 culture, Food and Rural Resources shall be announced  
24 by December 15th for the 3-year period.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

26

This amendment changes the minimum fair associa-  
27 tions' premium outlays from \$750 to \$1,200 in order  
28 to qualify for stipends, it changes the date for  
29 application of licenses and it requires announcement  
30 of assigned dates for the succeeding 3-year cycle by  
31 December 15th.
