STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to stop motor fuel refiners or distributors from preventing retailers from offering discounts for cash purchases. The bill also prevents refiners and distributors from charging retailers a certain percentage handling fee for sales made by them with the refiner's or distributor's credit cards.

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
