**AN ACT to Require Social Workers Employed
by Hospitals to be Registered.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

32 MRSA §7003, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 673, §3, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill removes the exemption currently granted to persons employed by licensed hospitals who practice social work and requires them to be registered with the State Board of Social Worker Registration.
