14 15	'§2216. Prescriptions written on hospital prescription blanks
16 17 18 19	Any physician, dentist or veterinarian who writes a prescription upon a prescription blank of a hospital or clinic shall sign his name and cause his name to be printed, stamped or typed on the blank.
20 21 22 23 24 25 26	This section also applies to any physician's assistant or registered nurse who writes a prescription while working under the control or supervision of a physician. In the case of the physician's assistant or registered nurse, the name of the physician under whom he works shall be printed, stamped or typed on the blank.'
27	STATEMENT OF FACT
28 29	This amendment changes the current language from "print or type his name" to also include "stamped."
30 31 32 33	This amendment adds that this requirement also applies to physicians' assistants and nurses, who must also provide the name of the physician under whose control or supervision they work.
