20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 5 MRSA §1813-A is enacted to read:

23 §1813-A. Promulgation of guidelines

24 The State Purchasing Agent, with the approval of
25 the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, shall
26 adopt and publish specific guidelines for the compet-
27 itive bidding process, including, but not limited to,
28 criteria for selection, award, notification procedure
29 and administrative appeal of award by a person
30 aggrieved thereby.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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A number of recent problems have arisen due to the absence of clearly delineated guidelines for state contract process and appeal of decisions considered adverse by applicants or bidders.

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
