21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1253, sub-§1-A is enacted to  
24 read:

25 1-A. Residents in unorganized territory. Not-  
26 withstanding any other provision of this Title, resi-  
27 dents in the unorganized territory whose children  
28 attend a school in an administrative district may  
29 vote, at the nearest polling place in a municipality  
30 within that administrative district, for school  
31 directors to be elected at that polling place.
