10	Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1
11	and inserting in its place the following:
12	'Sec. 1. 21 MRSA §604, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by
13	PL 1975, c. 165, §2, is amended to read:
14	A. "Accessible voting place" means a voting
15	place in a building in which has at least one
16	entrance that provides access, by ramp or other-
17	wise, to physically handicapped or elderly voters
18	and in which the voting place is located on the
19	first floor or is accessible by elevator or in a
20	building which meets the part of the building set
21 22	aside for voting meets the requirements for
23	accessible routes of the 1981 standards of con-
23	struction described in Title 25, chapter 331.
24	Further amend the Bill in section 2 in subsection
25	2 by adding at the end the following:
26	'A. The Secretary of State shall grant a waiver
27	from the requirements of this subsection to any
28	municipality which can satisfactorily demonstrate
29	that those requirements ought not to apply or
30	would create an extreme hardship. Factors which
31	the Secretary of State may consider in making
32	that determination include, but are not limited
33	to, the following: The municipality has no handi-
34	capped voters and the physical limitations of a
35	voting place make it impractical to provide an
36	accessible voting place as described in subsec-
37	tion 1.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 728, L.D. 937

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5 6	The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that only that part of a building set aside as the voting place must be accessible to disabled and elderly persons and that only the accessible route standard of construction must be satisfied.
7 8 9 10	The amendment also allows for a waiver to be granted by the Secretary of State to towns which satisfactorily demonstrate that the requirement to provide at least one accessible voting place in the town ought not to apply.
