20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7468 is enacted to read:

23 §7468. Taking coyote by holding snare

24 It is lawful to take coyote within the State by
25 use of holding snare. The commissioner may, by rule,
26 regulate the taking of coyote with holding snares.
27 The commissioner may extend the season on coyote in
28 any part of the State if, in his opinion, that action
29 is necessary.
