COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 316,
L.D. 952, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds for
Independent Living Services for the Disabled."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part design-
ated "§3081." in the 3rd line from the end (page 2,
line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words
"the Maine Independent Living Center" and inserting
in their place the underlined words 'providers of
independent living services'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§3081." in the last line (page 2, line 6
in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word and
punctuation "persons." the following: 'Funds shall be
disbursed and audited in accordance with departmental
grant policies and procedures. The department shall
submit an annual accounting of the program to the
joint standing committee of the Legislature having
jurisdiction over appropriations and financial
affairs.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§3082." by striking out all of subsec-
tions 3 and 4.

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking
out all of those parts designated "§3083." and
"§3084."

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking
out all of the last line (page 3, line 30 in L.D.)
and inserting in its place the following:

'Independent Living Services

All Other \$500,000 \$500,000'
