impairment, he or a member of the household must rely on a teletypewriter for telephone communications, and that such equipment is connected to his telephone.

This rate reduction shall also apply on intrastate toll calls made by the customer from a teletypewriter telephone and charged to his residential number.

The commission shall establish a 50% rate reduction for intrastate toll calls made from nonprofit agencies which serve the hearing-impaired community. To qualify for the reduction, an agency must annually file an affidavit, on a form approved by the commission, with the telephone company stating their purposes, clientele and information on their contracts to serve the hearing-impaired community.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Although current law allows a rate reduction for hearing-impaired phone customers on calls made from their own phone, it does not cover circumstances where the hearing-impaired person wishes to make a call from another teletypewriter phone, for example at a friend's home or from an office or public teletypewriter phone. The bill would correct that gap.

The bill also provides for a reduced rate for teletypewriter usage for agencies which serve the hearing-impaired community.

In both cases, the rate reduction is commensurate to the greater length of time needed to complete a teletypewriter call.
