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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes that fuel cost adjustments for electric utilities under Title 35, section 131 and for gas utilities under Title 35, section 132 are both excluded from the one-year prohibition on the rate filings. The failure to make an exception for fuel adjustment proceedings for gas utilities appears to be an oversight and this bill provides uniform treatment for both electric and gas utilities.

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
