HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 765, L.D. 965,
Bill, "AN ACT to Restrict the Open Season on Partridge."

Amend the bill by adding at the end before the statement of fact the following new sentence to read:

'In Cumberland, Hancock, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc, Waldo, Washington and York counties, the open season may be extended no later than December 21st. In the event the weather conditions are adversely affecting grouse, the commissioner shall close the season.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for an extended partridge hunting season in the coastal counties, as long as there is not snow on the ground.
