AN ACT to Restrict the Open Season on
Partridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7455, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended by adding before subsection 1 a new paragraph to read:

The open season on hunting partridge shall not extend any later than November 30th in any calendar year, except as provided in subsection 1.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft changes the termination date on hunting partridge to November 30th, except if the Governor orders the woods closed during that season, the commissioner may, with the consent of the Governor, extend the season up to the number of days the woods were closed.
