1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to provide the
3 Commissioner of Labor with the necessary authority to
4 administer the Bureau of Employment Security and the
5 unemployment insurance law. This amendment requires
6 the Unemployment Insurance Commission to obtain the
7 consent of the Commissioner of Labor prior to the
8 commission promulgating rules. In this way, the
9 administrative authority of the commissioner is not
10 obstructed.
