Remove provisions for court-appointed counsel 25 for a claimant under the wrongful imprisonment chap-26 ter. Since the action for wrongful imprisonment is a 27 civil action and not a criminal proceeding, a claim-28 ant may make an arrangement for contingent fees with 29 an attorney under Maine Bar Rule 8. This means that the attorney's fees for representation of the claim-30 ant will be paid out of the damages from the State for wrongful imprisonment if the claimant is success-31

ful. The attorney's fees are therefore contingent on

successfully arguing the case. Under these condi-
